Pope Francis closed the 2018 Synod of Bishops on 27th October. "We have made the document, we have studied it, we have approved it. Now the Holy Spirit gives us the document to work in our heart," Pope Francis told the 250 Bishops, Nuns, and young people in synod hall at the conclusion of voting. The final document of the fifteenth ordinary synod touches on controversial topics, such as homosexuality. "It was the Spirit at work here," Francis said.
