SONS AND DAUGHTERS OF GOD. Remember the many men and women who are living in inhumane conditions or who are suffering from addiction – and recall that Christ came into the world to bring love, justice, peace, and freedom, Pope Francis said on Hogmanay. "God the Father sent his Only Son into the world to eradicate from the human heart the long-standing slavery of sin, and thus restore our dignity," the Pope said. "And now we must stop," he continued, "stop and reflect with pain and repentance because, even during this year that draws to a close, so many men and women have lived and do live in conditions of slavery unworthy of human beings." In a brief homily during Vespers in St. Peter's Basilica, Francis urged Catholics to think of those who do not have a home, especially during the harsh winter months. "They are all sons and daughters of God, but different forms of slavery, sometimes very complex, have led them to live at the limits of human dignity," he said.
