YOUNG ADULTS PILGRIMAGE TO ROME. Join Young Adults from across the Diocese for a 5 day/ 4 night pilgrimage to Rome from 12th – 16th October 2026. GOSPEL: Matthew 5:13-16

At that time: Jesus said to his disciples,
'You are the salt of the earth,
but if salt has lost its taste, how shall its saltiness be restored?
It is no longer good for anything except to be thrown out
and trampled under people's feet.



'You are the light of the world.
A city set on a hill cannot be hidden.
Nor do people light a lamp and put it under a basket,
but on a stand,
and it gives light to all in the house.
In the same way, let your light shine before others,
so that they may see your good works
and give glory to your Father who is in heaven.

In this Gospel passage, immediately after the Beatitudes, Jesus says to his disciples: "You are the salt of the earth ... You are the light of the world". This surprises us a bit when we think of those who were before Jesus when he spoke these words. Who were these disciples? They were fishermen, simple people... But Jesus sees them with God's eyes, and his assertion can be understood precisely as a result of the Beatitudes. He wishes to say: if you are poor in spirit, if you are meek, if you are pure of heart, if you are merciful... you will be the salt of the earth and the light of the world! Pope Francis

PROMPTS FOR FAITH SHARING

Reflect on a time when you were in need and someone responded to that need with generosity. How were they God's light for you?

Can you think of a time when you had the opportunity to be God's light for someone else? How did you respond to the invitation?

How can you stay committed to works of mercy and justice when our earthly eyes do not always see the rewarding beauty that God promises in these readings?
